5. Reporting requirements

FINAL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED BY BUREAU VERITAS TO ISSUE REPORT:

- Final invoice,
- Certificate of origin / analysis / sanitary, for sensitive products (drugs medicines, foodstuff...),
 - Packing list, price list etc. where deemed necessary.

- CRF (Clean Report of findings), where the physical and documentary inspections are "satisfactory"

6. Inspection fees

1% of the FOB value for which an inspection has been demanded, with a USD 350 minimum fee per inspection + control testing fee, if applicable.

Paid by the EXPORTER to Bureau Veritas BIVAC BV whenever an application for pre-shipment inspection is made.

Nevertheless, Bureau Veritas/BIVAC may invoice the Seller in the event of supplementary inspection visits (in vain or unsatisfactory results). The costs incurred by the Seller in presenting the goods for inspection, such as unpacking, handling, testing, sampling, repacking... are for the account of the Seller.
